

Responsibilities:

- Child/client intakes and assessment interviews.
- Create comprehensive client treatment plans and review/revise as necessary.
- Complete client evaluations and discharge summaries.
- Conduct individual and/or group therapy sessions with children.
- Prepare and maintain up-to-date client records.
- Maintain continuous communication with supervisor, colleagues and clients.
- Participate in weekly case management staff meetings.
- Complete monthly, quarterly, and annual statistical and narrative reports as required. Complete additional reports as necessary.
- Provide client advocacy and referral services as needed.
- Attend trainings as required.
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Credentials:

Masters degree in creative arts therapy (art, music, drama, or dance/movement therapy). Must be board certified or certification eligible. Experience working with children and a valid driver's license required. Experience working with victims of domestic violence preferred. Bi-lingual/bi-cultural a plus.

Hours:

Full time (40 hours/week) day and early evening hours, Monday through Friday. Weekends and holidays, if necessary. Work hours flexible, will be arranged according to the program schedule and client's needs (approximately 10 am – 6 pm/11 am – 7 pm/12-8 pm, Monday through Friday)
