The Vice President of Public Policy and Emerging Issues is responsible for oversight of NNEDV's coalition technical assistance program, public policy initiatives and building and strengthening relationships with governmental entities. This position works closely with membership coalitions and the Policy and Program committee to ensure NNEDV's policy agenda and technical assistance addresses emerging issues, gaps identified in the field and the needs of membership. The Vice President of Public Policy and Emerging Issues supervises the Program and Policy teams as well as NNEDV's Transitional Housing program.

Qualified candidates will have the following related skills and experience:

- At least five years experience providing oversight of agency programs.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
